# **AGREED CONCLUSIONS AND ACTIONS:**

	Action	
•	The Chair and the Co-Chair of the TWG 3 acknowledged the guidance of the VEPG Steering Committee that the VEPG should leverage synergies with the various bi-lateral VEPG partner invents and decided to organize the 3 <sup>rd</sup> TWG 3 meeting in coordination with and integrated to the MOIT/World Bank consultation workshop on the Direct Power Purchase Agreement (DPPA) on 12 June 2019 ( <i>Public consultation Workshop on DPPA Design and Pilot Planning for Viet Nam</i> organized by USAID and MOIT/ERAV).	
•	The model DPPA mechanisms selected by ERAV/USAID was the synthetic model that uses the wholesale market and the Power Companies as retailers. The synthetic model was chosen for implementation.	ERAV
•	The model will be further examined and the DPPA pilot developed accordingly.	
•	A pilot program for 300 MW will be implemented in Mid-2020 to 2023.  Objective: test the DPPA mechanism in a controlled manner prior to acceptance and rollout  Suggested range of project sizes 5 to 60 MW	ERAV
•	The Co-Chair, Mr. Franz Gerner, Lead Energy Economist, World Bank in Vietnam announced that he finished his term at the World Bank in Viet Nam. He reaffirmed WB's commitment to continue their co-chairmanship of the TWG 3 on Energy Sector Reform.  Mr. Rahul Kitchlu, Energy Sector Coordinator of the World Bank Viet Nam will take over the co-chairmanship of the TWG 3 from Mr. Franz Gerner effectively starting in July (introduction in next TWG meeting in September 2019). 



Integration of the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Meeting of TWG 3 into the DPPA Workshop	The Chair and the Co-Chair of the TWG 3 agreed that the VEPG should leverage synergies with VEPG partners and the members of the TWGs. As the Direct Power Purchasing Agreement (DPPA) is part of the TWG 3 policy recommendations endorsed by the HLM 2018, the Chair and Co-Chair also agreed that the 3 <sup>rd</sup> meeting of TWG 3 should be integrated into the <i>Public consultation Workshop on DPPA Design and Pilot Planning for Viet Nam</i> organized by USAID and ERAV.	
Introduction of DPPA for Viet Nam	<ul> <li><u>USAID/VLEEP</u> introduced their activities in collaboration with ERAV to develop a DPPA mechanism in Viet Nam with the objective to enable large electricity consumers to contract with renewable power project developers, providing them with a pathway for meeting their renewable energy goals.</li> <li>The goal of the ERAV/VLEEP collaboration is to support regulations and policy to enhanced Vietnam's renewable energy market and launch the DPPA pilot program in late -2019/early 2020.</li> </ul>	
	The pilot program objectives are:	
	<ul> <li>to test the DPPA mechanism in a controlled manner prior to acceptance and rollout;</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Develop the capacity of power sector agencies to deliver the functionality required to implement the DPPA mechanism;</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Identify and correct any deficiencies of the design prior to committing time, energy or resources to a full-scale DPPA program;</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Confirm market demand and willingness to pay off large energy consumers in Viet Nam;</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Build credibility for DPPA mechanism that is aligned with the overall development of the VWEM and also provides the pathway to zero- emissions electricity that many corporate consumers desire;</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Establish more accurate costing for the distribution of power to support the DPPA pilot program and further development of the electricity market;</li> </ul>	
	• The implementation of DPPA in Viet Nam benefits for Power Consumers, Power sellers and the Government.	
Model Selection	<u>USAID/VLEEP</u> presented four options for the DPPA model based on the leading practices, private sector input, implementation success in other jurisdictions.	





 The DPPA model should take into account economic and financial impacts, market considerations, operational considerations, and legal and regulatory considerations. Synthetic DPPA – Option D was selected as the DPPA mechanism.



## Pilot Design and Implementation Plan

A Pilot Programme with a total capacity of 300 MW will be implemented in mid-2020 to 2023 with the objective to test the DPPA mechanism in a controlled manner prior to acceptance and rollout. The suggested range of the projects to participate in the pilot is between 5 to 60 MW. The timeline for implementation of the pilot is detailed below:
